1. Monitoring and Evaluation

- Outcome of strategy is evaluated over 5 years.
- Establishes a baseline for improvement
- A mechanism for reflection & where required, for corrective action
- NUST-NELGA Hub to assess extensive and varied range of planned interventions for improving land governance and administration.
- Given the limited funding available, it is critical that good evidence is available for decision making regarding critical resource allocation decision.
