Marginalized and Vulnerable Groups

1. Monitoring and Evaluation

- Outcome of Strategy is evaluated over 5 years.
- A mechanism for reflection & where required, for corrective action (Voluntary – Not Statutory or Contractual)
- NUST-NELGA Hub to assess its own performance
- Guide NUST-NELGA Hub in decision making regarding critical resource allocation decision.
- Organised around academic functions
- Achievements in framework can be costed
- Designed for robustness and simplicity
