

## **CALL FOR PAPERS: REAL ESTATE CONFERENCE IN ARUSHA DURING 10TH -13TH SEPTEMBER 2019**

The Eastern Africa Chapter of the AfRES is organizing and hosting an important African Real Estate Conference in Arusha during 10th -13th September 2019. Call for papers is still open on any of the topics as outlined in the conference theme and sub-themes. Conference registration will also be soon open.

The 19<sup>th</sup> African Real Estate Conference (AfRES) takes place in Arusha, Tanzania from 10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Arusha hosted the historic 3<sup>rd</sup> AfRES Conference in 2001 which ignited the momentum that has since then driven the African Real Estate Conferences around the continent attracting around 20 universities that are now affiliated to AfRES and members from 15 African Countries from the three chapters that form the AfRES. Arusha is poised to be yet another historic pad for launching of the much awaited 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of AfRES Conference in 2020.

### **19<sup>th</sup> Conference Theme**

The theme for the 19<sup>th</sup> Conference is ‘**The New Frontiers**’ which takes cognizance of the evolving dialogues from the past 18 annual conferences which have either been on natural resources management (land, sustainability and environment) during the early years (2001-2007) and real estate markets in the latter years (2009-2018). The New Frontiers will exemplify the emerging issues to the 21<sup>st</sup> Century discourse about the 4<sup>th</sup> Industrial Revolution and Smart Technologies application in real estate education and practice.
