Overview

The Network of Excellence on Land Governance in Africa (NELGA) Southern Africa, hosted by the Namibian University of Science and Technology (NUST), seeks to engage qualified 1-2 consultants for a research/documentation project that aims to evaluate and enhance the current land governance training programs across Southern Africa.

Objectives of Consultant

- Identify and document the profiles of the land governance programmes offered by NELGAaffiliated institutions in Southern Africa.
- Identify critical gaps in existing training programs and opportunities for interdisciplinary approaches to land governance education.
- Present the programme documentation at a validation workshop in November or December 2024.
- Develop recommendations for strengthening collaboration between universities, government agencies, and industry professionals to foster curricular innovation.

Scope of Work

- Review the current land governance programme to identify areas for improvement and innovation.
- Develop a report of land governance programmes compilation, with their current profiles and narrative recommendations for enhancing the quality and relevance of land governance training programs.
- Facilitate workshops to validate and finalize recommendations.

Required Qualifications

- At least a master's degree in land governance and related subjects.
- Familiarity with the African Land Policy Centre (ALPC) Curriculum Development Guidelines and NELGA's mission.
- Proven experience in land governance, education, curriculum and programme development.
- Previous experience in land governance and related report documentation is an advantage.

The consultancy is a 4-month task to be completed by 15th November 2024
